



Over the last ten years, the “Bucks for Brains” partnership between the University of Kentucky’s Research Challenge Trust Fund and the Commonwealth of Kentucky has yielded impressive results. Since its inception, the Commonwealth has pledged over \$230 million in state funds to the University of Kentucky, which we matched – dollar for dollar – with private funds to support the research enterprise of our institution. We’ve used these funds:

- As an essential part of our successful \$1 billion campaign, making us one of only 31 American universities – public and private – to do so, at the time.
- As part of the effort to build the University’s endowment from \$420.8 million in Fiscal Year 2001 to \$881.9 million as of June, 30, 2011 – in spite of the dramatic downturn in the stock market and stagnant recovery over the last several years.
- To create more than 300 endowed chairs and professorships.
- To create more than 260 fellowships, scholarships, and endowments to support research and for the William T. Young Library.
- As a key component of increasing our external grants and contracts from \$173.6 million in Fiscal Year 2001 to nearly \$300 million in Fiscal Year 2011.
- As a mechanism to expand state-of-the-art research space. Through increased flexibility with the “Bucks for Brains” partnership, we opened the \$18.6 million, LEED-Gold Davis Marksbury Building as the second piece of the University’s Digital Village.

The benefits of this partnership – spanning more than a decade – profoundly impact our promise to Kentucky. We have leveraged these resources in ways that support our students, faculty, and staff, and expand the boundaries of conventional thought pushing us beyond the brink of exceptional discovery.

The “Bucks for Brains” partnership between UK, our generous supporters, and Kentucky is an example of how creative approaches will help us continue our ascent and, as a result, improve the lives of citizens across the state.

FOCUS ON FACULTY



Linda Van Eldik, Dr. E. Vernon Smith and Eloise C. Smith Alzheimer's Research Chair

The intention when Linda Van Eldik took over as Sanders-Brown Center on Aging director in February 2010 was for her to work with William Markesberry, founding director of the center, on the Alzheimer's Disease Center (ARC) renewal proposal. After all, Markesberry had received more NIH grants than any other researcher at UK and had successfully competed for the ARC grant many times since UK first received it in 1985. As fate had it, Markesberry passed away before Van Eldik officially took the reins. But she says UK's success in securing the \$7 million grant from the National Institute on Aging, which will fund the center through 2016, is a testament to the legacy of the Sanders-Brown Center and a confirmation of the quality of its researchers and

volunteers. Van Eldik says, "This five-year renewal in funding will enable us to continue our mission of research, education outreach and clinical programs. Over the next five years we're going to be focusing on the theme 'Transitions and Translation.' She explains that "transitions" refers to understanding the earliest changes in the brain that underlie the progression from normal brain aging to Alzheimer's disease. "Translation" refers to turning that basic scientific knowledge more efficiently and rapidly into treatments that will help Kentucky's aging population. Center programs include telemedicine to assess cognitive skills and deliver support to caregivers throughout the state, and the African American Dementia Outreach Partnership that works with local agencies to offer the resources of the university to those who can most benefit from them. More than 700 research volunteers participate in clinical trials and the brain donation program.



Gregory Jicha, Robert T. and Nyle Y. McCowan Alzheimer's Research Chair

Gregory Jicha, an associate professor of neurology who works in the Sanders-Brown Center on Aging, is spearheading a project called Telemedicine Assessment of Cognition in Rural Kentucky. The goal of the project, which began in fall 2008, is to adapt and validate the Uniform Data Set (a standard set of questions, developed by the National Institute on Aging, asked of every patient being screened for Alzheimer's) and other measures for diagnosing early dementia in the telemedicine setting. A related and obviously important goal is to determine whether these consultations, part of the Memory Disorders Clinic, are as effective as face-to-face meetings with a doctor. Jicha says, "Our goal is to ensure that though telemedicine is not better than an in-person evaluation, it's as good as an in-person evaluation. And ours is the first study in the nation that has convincingly shown that to be true." The Memory Disorders Clinic is one of 12 ongoing telemedicine clinics at UK. "Many people don't realize it," Jicha says, "but UK probably has the best telemedicine system network in the world. Our telemedicine clinics actually allow us to cover the entire state, from Pikeville to Paducah, providing services where they're needed." Jicha is also involved in a spinal fluid donation project. Scientists can test cerebral spinal fluid for altered proteins associated with Alzheimer's disease. These so-called biomarkers are a sign of chemical changes in the brain long before a person develops the symptoms of Alzheimer's.



Susanne Arnold,

Rose Carol Shumate Professor in Cancer Research

Susanne Arnold, an associate professor of medicine who specializes in lung cancer research, received a three-year, \$1.6 million grant from the Department of Defense to study potential environmental reasons for lung cancer rates in Eastern Kentucky. Kentucky has the highest lung cancer rates in the nation, but counties in the southeastern portion of the state—those in the 5th Congressional District—have an exceptionally high incidence of lung cancer, 115.2 cases per 100,000 residents, compared to 61.6 cases per 100,000 residents nationally. "We know that tobacco is the number one cause of lung cancer, but that isn't the only factor causing the high cancer burden for southeastern Kentucky," Arnold says. In a previous study, Appalachian colon cancer patients had significantly higher amounts of arsenic, chromium and nickel than non-Appalachian patients. Although trace amounts of metals (such as iron) are necessary for the body's normal functions, prolonged exposure to trace elements including arsenic, beryllium, cadmium, cobalt, chromium, nickel, and vanadium has been linked to several types of cancer—including lung cancer. In Arnold's study, participants will fill out a questionnaire about smoking habits, and researchers will determine the amount of exposure to trace elements by taking toenail, hair, urine, and blood samples. To determine the source of the exposure, they'll also collect water and soil samples from the home. Arnold, a native of Kentucky, also spearheads the Marty Driesler Cancer Project, a partnership between the Markey Cancer Center and community health care providers in the 5th District targeting early detection, prevention and treatment of lung, liver and esophageal cancer.

Philip Kern,

Barnstable Brown Kentucky Diabetes and Obesity Center

Philip Kern, a professor of endocrinology and molecular medicine, serves as director of the Barnstable Brown Diabetes and Obesity Center. Kern says, "Having inflammatory cells in our fat tissue might have been a protective force once upon a time. If you just got gored by a saber tooth tiger while defending your home, you might want to have some inflammatory cells nearby in that superficial space to help fight off infection. Nature never imagined we would be as fat as we are now. So now a natural defense mechanism is going haywire as we get more and more obese." Kern points out that weight gain causes low-grade inflammation throughout our tissues, which makes us more resistant to the actions of insulin. He is partnering with Charlotte Peterson in the College of Health Sciences to understand the effects of exercise in maintaining insulin sensitivity and preventing diabetes. He is also looking at the anti-inflammatory benefit of omega 3 in fish oil. Kern explains, "We are recruiting people with pre-diabetes and putting them on fish oil and placebo. And then we are performing fat and muscle biopsies to look for changes in inflammation." Clinical trials of new drugs and therapies are an important part of UK's research enterprise. In June 2011, UK was awarded a \$20 million grant by the NIH's Clinical and Translational Science Awards (CTSA) program to further advance and support the UK Center for Clinical and Translational Science. The UK center—the only designated CTSA in Kentucky and one of only 60 nationwide—is led by Kern, associate provost for clinical and translational science. The goal of the CTSA: speed up the process of taking discoveries made in the lab to patients in the doctor's office.



FOCUS ON STUDENTS

The Endowment Match Program is not only a mechanism to recruit faculty. It also provides research opportunities and financial support for some of the most talented graduate students in the U.S. In Fiscal Year 2011, the Endowment Match Program provided graduate fellowships to 674 recipients.



FOCUS ON KENTUCKY

Bucks for Brains is a primary catalyst for the substantial growth in the external research funding coming to campus and to Kentucky. In Fiscal Year 2011, external research grants and contracts at the University totaled \$299.1 million (www.research.uky.edu/stats.html). This is up from \$122 million in 1997 (a 145 percent increase).

These dollars have an impact on UK's campus. During Fiscal Year 2011, these external research grants and contracts resulted in a \$422.3 million contribution to the Kentucky economy, including \$222.3 million in personal income. Externally supported research accounted for 10,726 jobs at UK and throughout Kentucky. Each dollar of out-of-state external funding for research generates approximately \$1.90 of total related expenditures.

ENDOWMENT ACTIVITY

The 2008 Kentucky General Assembly authorized \$33,333,000 in General Fund supported bonds for the University of Kentucky through the Research Challenge Trust Fund for the Endowment Match Program and the newly created Research Capital Match Program (designed to support capital projects). Pursuant to its statutory authority the University of Kentucky Board of Trustees allocated \$21,926,570 to the Research Capital Match Program and \$11,406,430 to the Endowment Match Program. As of June 30, 2011, the University has received \$11,061,130 in state Endowment Match Program funds from the 2008-10 appropriation. Since 1998, the University of Kentucky has used Bucks for Brains to:

- create 91 endowed chairs and 211 endowed professorships; and
- create 263 fellowships, lectures, enrichments, and endowments to support research and the William T. Young Library (Table 1).

Private donations and state matching funds supported the addition of one endowed chair, one endowed professorship, two endowed fellowships, and two endowed mission support projects and programs in Fiscal Year 2011 (Table 1).

ENDOWMENT MATCH PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

Endowment Match Program faculty have made substantial contributions to the University of Kentucky research portfolio. As of June 30, 2011, UK has 351 total active patents, primarily in drug development and drug design, plant biotech, equine health, and materials for medical implants, drug delivery systems and medical devices. Twenty-nine new patents were issued and 22 patent applications were filed in FY 2011. UK received \$1.2 million in licensing revenue, held a total of 169 licenses, and issued 20 new licenses, 11 of which went to UK start-up companies. According to the latest report from AUTM, the Association of University Technology Managers, UK ranks 4th in start-up companies among all public universities and 6th among all public and private institutions.

DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

As of June 30, 2011, the University of Kentucky has appointed a total of 202 faculty to endowed chairs and professorships under the auspices of the Endowment Match Program. Of those appointments, 158 (78 percent) are male, and 44 (22 percent) are female. Of the 890 research staff associated with the Bucks for Brains program, 430 (48.3 percent) are male, and 460 (51.7 percent) are female (Table 2).

During Fiscal Year 2011 there were 139 endowments supporting graduate fellowships. Since a single endowment may support multiple student awards, 674 graduate students received support from endowment proceeds (Table 4). There were 289 (42.9 percent) minority students among fellowship recipients.

AREAS OF CONCENTRATION

The Council on Postsecondary Education's 2002-04 and 2008-10 Endowment Match Program Guidelines stipulate that at least 70 percent of program funds at the research institutions must be used to support Research Challenge programs or academic disciplines contained within Kentucky's five new economy clusters: (1) human health and development; (2) biosciences; (3) materials science and advanced manufacturing; (4) information technologies and communications; and (5) environmental and energy technologies. The University of Kentucky directed 79.6 percent of the funds to support positions, programs, or projects within the new economy clusters (Table 5).

Pursuant to the 2002-04 and 2008-10 Endowment Match Program Guidelines, the University also directed at least 70 percent of program funds to support chairs, professorships or research scholars, and infrastructure or fellowships directly linked to the research activities of endowed chairs and professors.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

The University received \$340,000 of state matching funds in Fiscal Year 2011 (Table 6). The market value and accumulated fund balances, as of June 30, 2011, of all endowments created or expanded as part of the Endowment Match Program total \$423,867,097 (Table 7).
